On Tuesday, July 26th at 7 pm we will meet at one of our members' home for a very unusual garden tour. Member John Nuccitelli and his wife Diane have developed a remarkable collection of plants and animals which he will share with us. See the map for directions to John's home in Mendon.

Be prepared to feast your eyes on a Japanese garden designed by one famed designer, Dennis Burns, who is also a society member. Dwarf conifers, Japanese maples, bamboo, stones, blueberry bushes and a bonsai collection are featured in this distinctive garden with a tokonoma and many ponds and water plants. We will also see a 8,500 gallon pond which contains over 40 colorful and prize-winning Japanese koi. Since it might be difficult to see so many fish under water, John has installed "Koi TV", an underwater closed circuit TV projection system...

Don't miss this opportunity to visit a most unusual garden which is often featured on garden tours which charge for this special visit.
